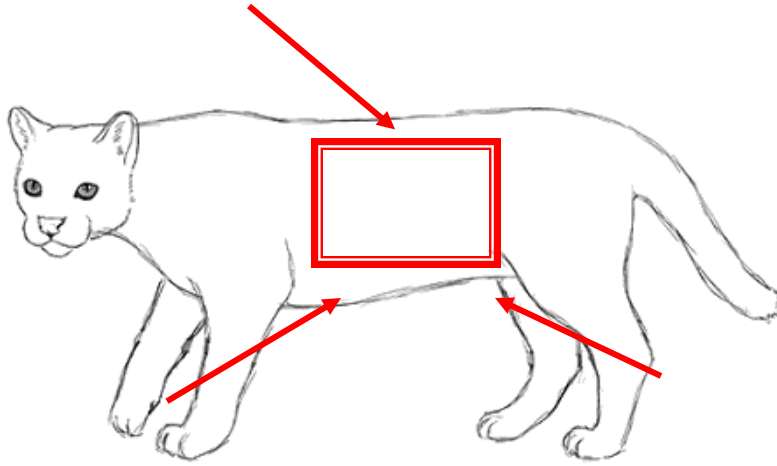
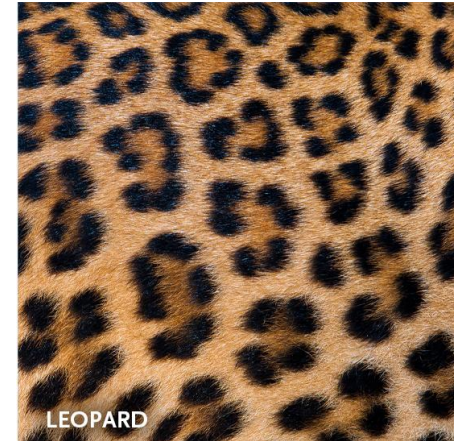


Bengal Cat Spot Size Scoring Reference Sheet

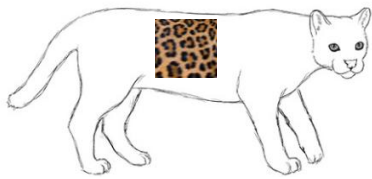


Spot Size – The size of the primary pattern markings on the side of the cat’s body in proportion to the cat’s overall body size. Consider none of these cats are ticked tabby variations.



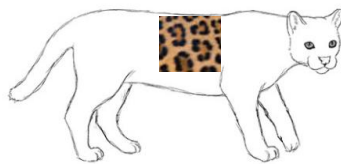
Confine the area of consideration to mid lateral surface of each cat, below dorsal surface and above ventral surface. Try to confine your consideration to the side abdominal (belly) surface of the cat behind the front legs, before the hips & thigh, below the curve of the body as it turns downward and above where the body turns inward to meet on the chest/abdomen. As you view, **DON'T CONSIDER THE TYPE** of the spotting/marking or pattern. **FOCUS ON THE SIZE of SPOTTING/MARKINGS** compared to the size of the cat.

Please rate what you see as follows:



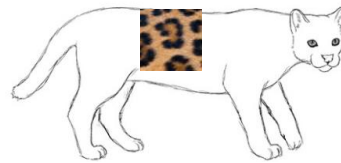

Spots no larger than the size of the cat’s nose tip or eye, not so small to be clearly visible. Many spots could fit on the cat’s side.



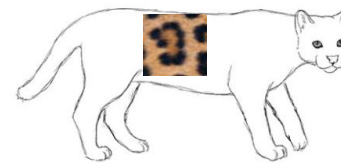

Large Spots are larger than nose tip or eye pupil, smaller than ear triangular shape. 30 spots might fit on cats’s side.



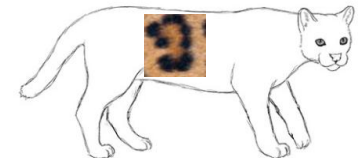

Big Spots are as large or slightly larger than ears but smaller than total head. 20 spots might fit on cat’s side.

Huge Spots are as large as large head. 6 -10 spots barely fit on cat’s side.

Giant Spots are larger than the cat’s head. Up to 5 spots could fit on the cat’s side.
