

Bengal Cat Spotting Type Scoring Reference Sheet



Primary Spotting
Type – The
predominant shape
of the largest
markings in the
mid lateral
abdomen, after the
front leg before
the thigh/hip




Confine the area of consideration to mid lateral surface of each cat, below dorsal surface and above ventral surface. Try to confine your consideration to the side abdominal (belly) surface of the cat behind the front legs, before the hips & thigh, below the curve of the body as it turns downward and above where the body turns inward to meet on the chest/abdomen. As you view, **TRY NOT TO CONSIDER THE SIZE** of the marking **ONLY THE SHAPE**.

Arrowhead triangular shape pointing from front to back of cat



Pawprint

small dots & spots surrounding a larger 3rd color, no spot, dot or line surrounds more than ½ or 50% of the center spot

Donut
51% or more than ½ the
rosette is surrounded by a
solid unbroken line of equal
thickness.

Clouded Rosette – A donut rosette with a THINNER front edge and THICKER rear edge
